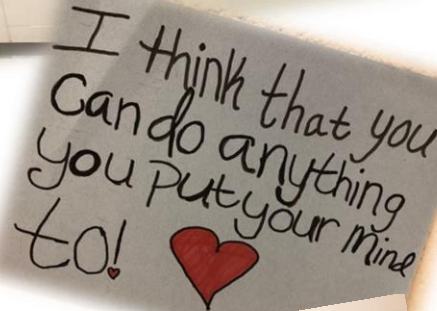


Camp Exceeds

Camp Exceeds offers a way to recognize and reward students who persevere to excel in their education this school year! Students who go above and beyond and earn “exceeds” will be rewarded by becoming a member of Camp Exceeds in addition to participating in a fun and exciting field trip excursion!

To qualify as a quarterly member of Camp Exceeds, students must excel in their SOAR behaviors (S-Stay Safe, O-Outstanding Attitude, A-Always Respectful, and R-Responsible) AND one or more of the following:

- Excel in SOAR behaviors and Academics (Exceeds in Reading, Math, and/or Writing).
- Excel in SOAR behaviors and Attendance (100% perfect attendance with zero absences, tardies, and early checkouts).
- Excel in SOAR behaviors and GLOs (4's in all GLO areas on the report card).

A small number of clearly defined behavioral expectations are defined in positive, simple, rules. At Maysville, our rules are shared as “Eagle Expectations” that align to the acronym, SOAR.

Eagle Expectations:

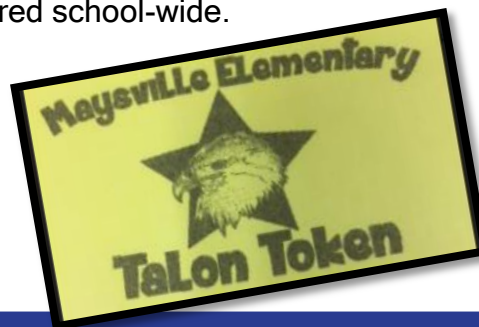
S - Stay Safe

A - Always Respectful

R - Responsible

At Maysville, students are recognized for meeting these behavior expectations through acknowledgement of “Talon Tokens”. There are also classroom rewards, quarterly celebrations, lunchroom rewards, quarterly awards ceremonies, and PBIS store that are offered school-wide.
